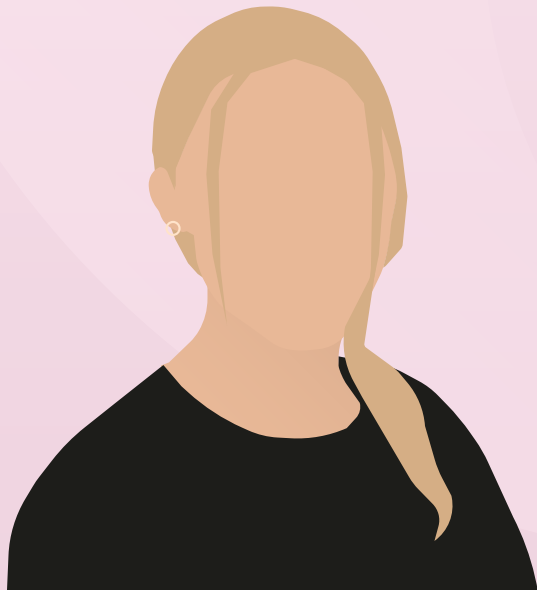


Meet... Natasha!
